TURF IS A LIVING PRODUCT

Freshly harvested turf is a living product and is highly vulnerable to heat stress once lifted.

When temperatures exceed **25°C**, turf can deteriorate rapidly if it isn't:



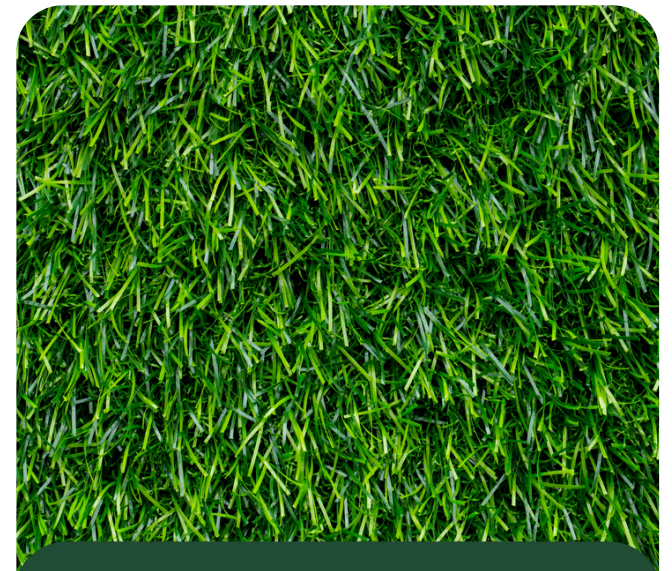
Laid Immediately



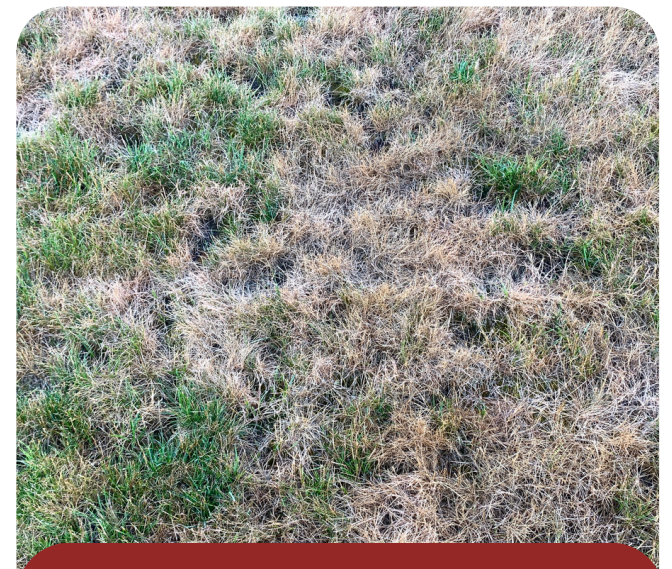
Watered thoroughly



Maintained Consistently



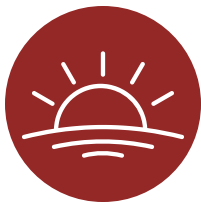

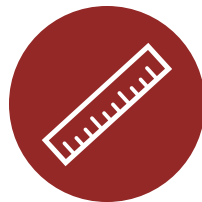
HEAT DAMAGED

RISK OF INSUFFICIENT WATERING

Without adequate irrigation, the following issues can occur:



Turf drying out and overheating on site



Shrinkage and visible gaps between rolls



Root stress and poor establishment



Yellowing, scorching and dieback



Reduced plot presentation and overall quality



Increased remedial costs and customer complaints

SITE READINESS CHECKLIST

To achieve the best possible results during hot weather, the following conditions should be met:

- ✓ Ground preparation completed prior to delivery
- ✓ Turf laid immediately upon arrival
- ✓ Watering commenced straight away and maintained consistently
- ✓ Adequate labour and water supply available on site
- ✓ Ongoing aftercare guaranteed, particularly on unoccupied plots
- ✓ Water source available within vicinity to allow for immediate watering once laid

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ESSENTIAL FOR SUCCESS

Immediately after laying:



Water Straight Away



Continue watering daily



Increase frequency during hot weather



Monitor newly laid areas closely



Pay particular attention to unoccupied plots



During prolonged warm weather, watering may be required multiple times per day.

PROTECT YOUR INVESTMENT

When turf is installed without adequate irrigation or aftercare arrangements in place, any deterioration, shrinkage, drying out or turf failure cannot be attributed to our workmanship and **may not be eligible for replacement.**
